COMPETITION PHASES

Phase 1: Submit Your Idea

Phase 2: Evaluation- During the national events, ideas will be reviewed to select finalists

Phase 3: Final Pitch- Winners of the national competitions will participate in the ceremony in Milan in March 2026, with free travel and stay. During that event, we will announce the results of the international finals

Phase 4: Acceleration — the best idea will be further developed, and the winner will receive a €500 scholarship





JUDGING CRITERIA

A panel consisting of experienced professionals and entrepreneurs will evaluate the submissions based on the following criteria:

Creativity and Originality: The extent to which the idea or project demonstrates innovative thinking, uniqueness, and inventive approaches. **MAX 5 score**

Economic Viability: The potential for financial sustainability and success, including an assessment of the target customers, the value proposition offered, and the strategic partnerships that can support growth and scalability.

Social Impact and Innovation: The ability of the project to create positive social change, address societal challenges, and introduce innovative solutions that contribute meaningfully to the community or environment.
